

# Problem Solving Using Root Cause Analysis to Solve Challenging Situations Effectively

**Course Objective:** Participants will learn to effectively use Problem Solving and Root Cause Analysis (RCAA) tools to identify potential causes of business challenges and address them by implementing impactful solutions to prevent recurrence. The course follows the DMAIC (Define, Measure, Analyze, Improve, and Control) 5-step systematic methodology commonly applied in various business fields, as well as Lean Six Sigma.

**Who should attend?** Those who are responsible for identifying and addressing problems including quality personnel, business process managers, process users, and any team members involved in quality and continuous improvement initiatives.

## Training Topics to include:

The DMAIC Problem Solving Process is a data-driven methodology used to improve processes by identifying and addressing defects or inefficiencies.
