JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

- Comply with state and national truck driving rules and regulations
- Inspect vehicles for mechanical items and safety issues
- Maneuver trucks into loading or unloading positions
- Report defects, accidents, or violations
- Plan routes and meet delivery schedules
- Properly document and log time and miles
